

Caribou Utilities District General Manager

The Board of Trustees of the Caribou Utilities District (CUD) is seeking applicants for the position of General Manager. The CUD provides water and wastewater service to the City of Caribou, Maine with a staff of nine and annual budget of \$2.28 million. The General Manager works under the direction of a five-person Board of Trustees and will be responsible for the overall leadership and management as well as the daily operational activities of the CUD including customer and employee relations, budgeting, long range planning and system operations. Candidates should have a broad range of management, computer and technical skills and a college degree or equivalent experience, preferably in a utility environment. The candidate must: be knowledgeable of State of Maine and Federal water and wastewater regulations, laws, and permits; and hold or be able to obtain State of Maine appropriate water and wastewater licenses within one year of employment. An engineering degree and professional registration is preferred but not required. Salary is negotiable and commensurate with experience.
