Update on the Police Station Project June 24, 2024

Artifex and Manns Woodward have been working on producing a police station design that will fit the original \$10,000,000 budget. This has meant going back to a one-story design.

Blackstone Land Surveying is working on a description of the parcel where the police station will be placed. This is needed for the environmental review.

The parcel where the police station will be located is tax-acquired property, acquired through the automatic lien foreclosure process for 2014 property tax liens. This presents new challenges considering the SCOTUS decision in the Tyler vs Hennepin County decision last year. We have received information from legal counsel that, since this was acquired in 2016, the time for challenging the foreclosure of the tax lien has expired.

The schematic updates are on the following three pages, along with the new estimated price of \$9,506,900.


